

Buzz Club Summer Savers' Program Guidelines

The following are the guidelines for Bronco FCU's Summer Savers' Program for the summer of 2010.

Each Buzz Club member that registers for the program will receive a savings card. This savings card will be used to record deposits made to the participant's Buzz Club Account at one of our locations. The participant will receive one point for each dollar that is deposited during the program. There will be an opportunity to earn **bonus** points if the child is present when the deposit is made. The points earned during the program will be transferred to a certificate. The participant can redeem the certificate for prizes at our annual Paint Your Pumpkin event held in October. If the participant chooses, they may donate the points to the Ronald McDonald House instead of purchasing prizes.

- Program dates are June 7, 2010 through September 3, 2010.
- Participants will earn one point for each dollar deposited into their Buzz Club account during the program.
- Savings card will be filled out at the time of the deposit by the Bronco employee. If the child is present at the time of the deposit the employee will add a stamp that will award 5 **bonus** points for the child being present. This will be the only record kept of the **bonus** points, so it is important to keep the savings card and bring it along when making deposits.
- We will also offer 5 **bonus** points to any participant that fills a Ronald McDonald "tab house" with aluminum can tabs for the Ronald McDonald Pop Tab Program. These can be turned in at any Bronco location during the Summer Savers' Program. Tabs must be turned in by September 3, 2010.
- There is a minimum of \$25 in deposits, which must remain in the account, during the program to qualify for prizes.
- Savings cards should be turned in to any Bronco location by September 17. Participants will in turn be mailed certificates for all points earned during the program.
- These certificates can be redeemed for prizes at Paint Your Pumpkin in October. We will have an alternate date to redeem prizes if the participant is unable to attend the Paint Your Pumpkin event.
- As an alternative to purchasing prizes with the points, the participant may "donate" the points to the Ronald McDonald House. Bronco will contribute \$0.10 for every point donated to the Ronald McDonald House Charities.
- Savings Bond forms will be available at registration if the parent would like for Bronco to order a \$50 EE Savings Bond for the participant. Bronco will withdraw \$25 from the participant's account to purchase the bond after the Summer Savers' Program has ended. A minimum of \$25 must be deposited into the participant's account during the program for the savings bond to be ordered.
