There are crimes that happen in real life, like theft, abuse and even bullying, that are now happening on the internet. It's your job to help protect yourself, your family and your friends, and you can do it by remembering these simple cyber safety tips:

- If you receive an email or message that asks for your personal information, like your name, address, age, phone number, school, or anything else, do not respond to the email and tell your parents immediately.
- When choosing a screen name or email address, choose one that does not contain your real name.
- Do not use the same password twice and do not share it with anyone other than your parents.
- Do not communicate with strangers online.
- If you see someone bullying another person on the internet, tell an adult right away.
